C&L COMPANIES OPENS DISTRIBUTION CENTER

[C&L Cos.](#) was welcomed into the “family” of Warren County companies at a ceremony Sunday at ‘The Farm’ in rural Warren County. The event was attended by company leaders, project partners, and over 100 motocross riders and distributors.

C&L Companies owner Curt Leaverton thanked the individuals and organizations that had a role in supporting the project. In all, well over 50 organizations and businesses were involved in completing the 25,000 square foot distribution center and road which serves the project. Indianola-based Downing Construction and Sternquist Construction were among the businesses involved.

The Warren County Board of Supervisors was specifically mentioned as instrumental in the project’s success. Warren County was able to finish the road with a grant from the Iowa DOT and zero interest financing from the USDA Rural Development, the latter of which was secured by Interstate Communications.

Representatives from the Iowa Area Development Group and Iowa Economic Development Authority were also on hand for the ceremony, which featured a ribbon cutting by the Indianola Chamber of Commerce. Clarke Electric Cooperative extended three-phase electric power for the project and Warren Rural Water also extended services. The Greater Des Moines Partnership assisted in this project, too.

The facility houses non-engine components for two of C&L Companies’ businesses – Pivot Works and Bearing Connections. C&L Cos., with headquarters and manufacturing facility in Urbandale, expects the Warren County facility to expand as the company grows.
